B/ Well trained staff adherence to environmental health requirements

C/ A log book or recording system shall be kept upon the premises, in which shall be entered particulars if inspections made; those required to be made by statute, and information compiled to comply with any public safety condition attached to the premises license that requires the recording of such information

### D) THE PREVENTION OF PUBLIC NUISANCE

A/ Noise reduction measures to address the public nuisance objective:

quietly.

2) The Glass roofed 'conservatory' to the rear of the premises, being the closest part of the licensed property to residential dwellings, will be internally clad to ceiling space to dampen noise seepage and undertaken as a bottle and cellar storage with doors to reduce noise seepage and not used as a public area

E/ Any lighting on or outside the premises will be positioned and screened in such a way so as to not sauce a disturbance to nearby residents

G/ A designated taxi operator will be nominated for staff and customers use. The company's telephone number will be advertised to customers.
